Dear Members,

I am happy to report that in the past several months we've really gotten a lot of things done. You'll notice the grounds look cleaner, as we're caught up on weed abatement, including the berms. There is a new machine that will accept credit cards on the skeet field, and soon the pistol/ rifle range and bar will have that feature as well. The rental spaces have improved with respect to registered vehicles and excess junk, but there still some more work to be done.

We are currently working on creating a Standard Operating Procedures manual for each activity center, and the club in general, that will be bound into one publication. We have also increased the number of weekend range officers that man the 25 and 100 yard lines on the weekends, thus increasing safety. Being president is kind of fun. We have so many good things in our club, and such great members. I am looking forward to getting as many things done that I can before my term is up.
