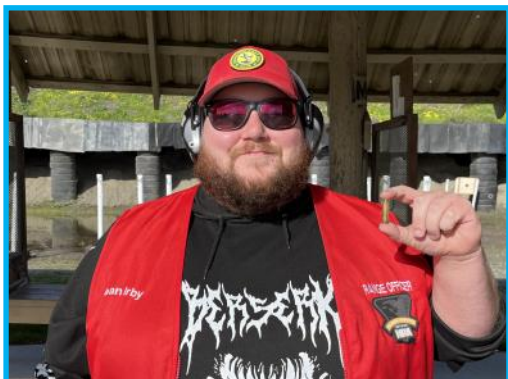

RIFLE & PISTOL RANGE—MEMBER SPOTLIGHT JEAN IRBY

Jean Irby is our March 2025 Volunteer Spotlight. Jean comes from a long family lineage of shooting sports enthusiasts. Jean recalls when he was just five his grandfather got started with a .357 magnum and a .38 special. Jean's family includes military members, hunters, and sport shooters. Jean's grandfather worked at the Chevron refinery and used to talk about frequenting the Chevron Range. More recently, when Jean and his friends tried to find the Chevron Range they found the RRG instead. Jean started shooting at the RRG in 2020 and began volunteering on February 11, 2024 – Jean just celebrated his one-year volunteer anniversary.



Jean's most memorable moment to date is helping the young shooter "Heidi" and her father. Jean made such a positive impression that at the end of her shooting session, Heidi collected a .22 caliber shell casing, a 9mm shell casing, and a .357 mag shell casing. Heidi nested the three shell casings like a Russian nested doll set, presented them to Jean as a gift to thank him, and told him thank you and that the three nested casings are filled "Full of Luck". Jean keeps this gift with him in his vest pocket as a reminder of the good things that the volunteers bring to our customers. Take a gander when Jean is around and ask him about his nested shell casing good-luck charm. The Club is lucky to have Jean as a member and a volunteer!

RSATA (Richmond Skeet & Trap Association)



RSATA is a *fun* competition held on the Skeet & Trap Range the second Saturday of each month.

- 1) **NEW PARTICIPANTS ONLY** - First place for each of the two rounds will win \$20. Cannot be the same person.
- 2) **ALL PARTICIPANTS** - \$5 from every entry fee will go into a pot split 50/30/20% to be awarded at every RSATA event.



Entry per event is \$20 Skeet/\$20 Trap. (*Shells not included*).

Entry includes 2 rounds (50 clays) per discipline, you may enter Skeet, Trap, or both.

There are 2 series per year, each is 6 events (*Jan-June & July-Dec*) with your best 4 scores counted for awards presented twice a year.

Awards typically are belt buckles for winners of skeet classes A, B, and C and Trap A and B, with prizes for 2nd and 3rd places depending on the number of class participants.

- Shooters and guests must wear **EYE AND EAR PROTECTION**
- Gun muzzles must point in a safe direction
- Actions must remain open until it is your turn to shoot
- Do not load unless it is your turn and you are on station

- Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot
- Pick up your hulls when you are finished
