25 YARD LINE RULES REMINDERS

- ◆ Only pistol caliber guns, shotguns (with a stock and sighting device), and black powder pistols, rifles, and shotguns are permitted.
- ◆ Slide target in from the top in-between the plastic pipes.
- ◆ Ensure your bullet impact is into the berm between the stacks of tires.
- ◆ Only guns with sighting devices may be used.
- ◆ Must properly use sights on the gun.
- ◆ SLOW FIRE – 4 seconds between each shot.
- ◆ Shooting positions may only be from the seated on a stool or the standing position.

100 YARD LINE RULES REMINDERS

- ◆ All rifles new to this range, or with a different sighting device from a previous visit, must be bore-sighted, with RSO guidance.
- ◆ Shooting positions may be from prone, kneeling, seated, seated on a stool, or standing.
- ◆ Ensure your bullet impact is in the middle of the berm in both elevation and windage.
- ◆ Do not walk between shooting tables – Go to either pathways on either side of the shooting tables and walk down range – do not run.
- ◆ When firing, muzzles must extend at least 2 inches beyond the forward edge of the shooting table.
- ◆ Use brass ejection screens when necessary as a courtesy to your neighbors.
- ◆ Slide target cardboard into frame – Do Not Bend Cardboard.
- ◆ All frames moved to 50 yards must be returned to 100 yards before departing.

200 YARD RANGE RULES REMINDERS

- ◆ Use the 200 Yard Range in accordance with the 200 Yard Range Standard Operating Procedures.

RSATA

(Richmond Skeet & Trap Association)

RSATA is a *fun* competition held on the Skeet & Trap Range the second Saturday of each month. Entry per event is \$20 Skeet/\$20 Trap. (Shells not included).

Entry includes 2 rounds (50 clays) per discipline, you may enter Skeet, Trap, or both.

There are 2 series per year, each is 6 events (Jan-June & July-Dec) with your best 4 scores counted for awards presented twice a year.

Awards typically are belt buckles for winners of skeet classes A, B, and C and Trap A and B, with prizes for 2nd and 3rd places depending on the number of class participants.

1) NEW PARTICIPANTS ONLY - First place for each of the two rounds will win \$20.

2) ALL PARTICIPANTS - \$5 from every entry fee will go into a pot split 50/30/20% to be awarded at every RSATA event.

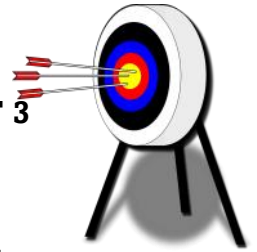

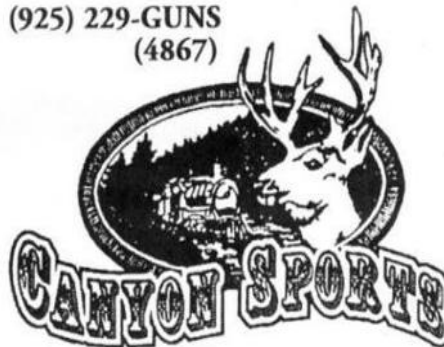
